Judging Criteria

Presenters are allowed three minutes and one static slide for their presentation and are judged on the following criteria on a scale of 1 (needs improvement) to 6 (excellent):

CONTENT ACCESSIBILITY

Does the presenter translate their outcomes and significance in an understandable and interesting way to a non-specialized audience? Do you want to learn more? Does their slide enhance the presentation's message?

DEPTH AND MASTERY OF TOPIC

Does the presenter demonstrate depth of mastery of their topic with a clear and logical structure? Do they spend adequate time for each section of their presentation?

DELIVERY

Does the speaker demonstrate strong public speaking skills—eye contact, stage confidence, comfortable pacing, body language, use of gestures, and vocal techniques (power, pause, pitch, etc.)—to engage the audience's interest and attention throughout the presentation?

INTELLECTUAL SIGNIFICANCE

Does the presenter clearly explain how/why their project advances (or matters to) their discipline AND/OR benefits (or matters to) other interested groups without trivializing or generalizing their project?
