


How to View Results/Originality Report for Turnitin LTI Enabled Assignments

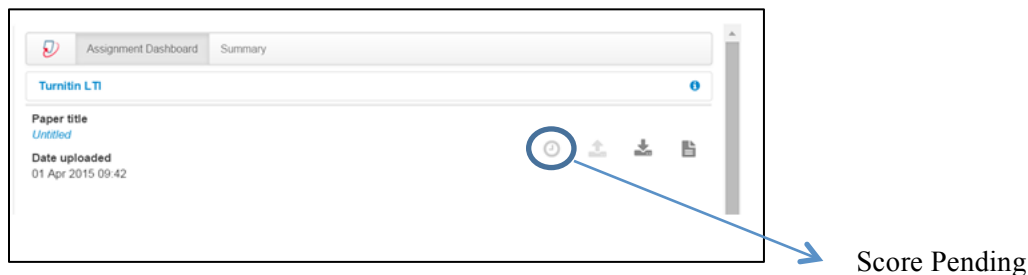
This document will teach you how to view the originality report for assignments submitted using Turnitin LTI (Learning Tools Interoperability) in Canvas.

Once you are logged into your Canvas account, go to Assignments section and select the assignment for which you need to view the originality score.

Originality Report:

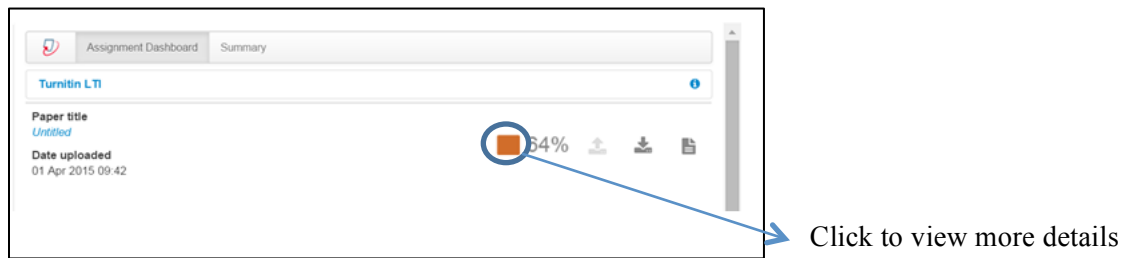
The color icons indicate the general level of the Originality Report. Possible colors are green, yellow, and orange, red, blue (no score) or gray (score pending). Click this icon to see the full Originality Report.

The below screen with the icon  is displayed, if Turnitin LTI is still processing your submitted document.

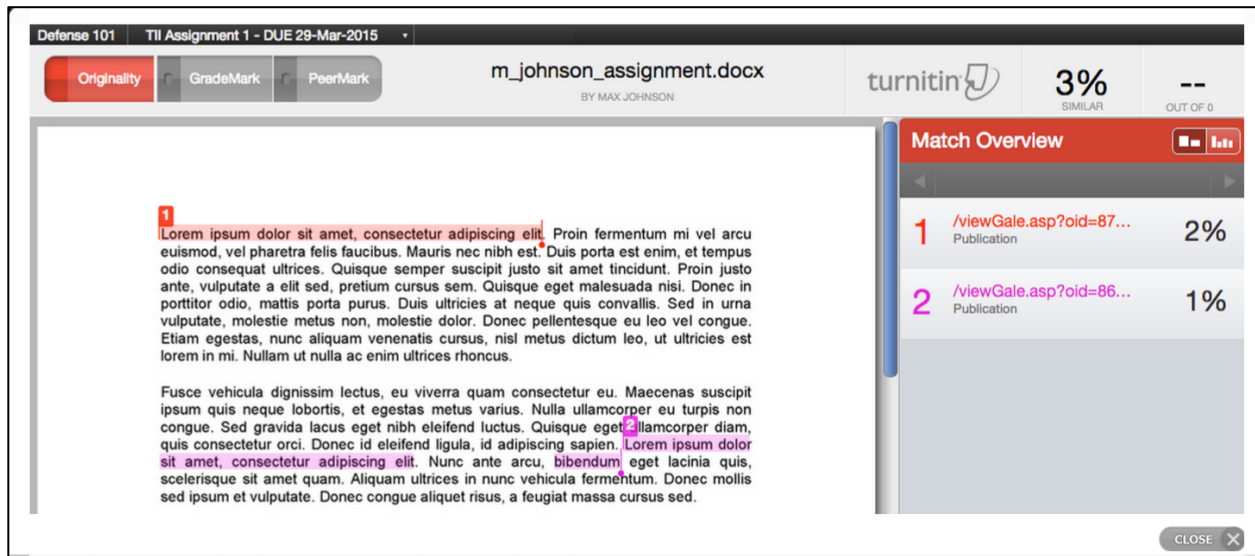


Once the document is processed, based on the originality percentage, different colored icons are replaced.

The screen below shows that the document is 64% similar.



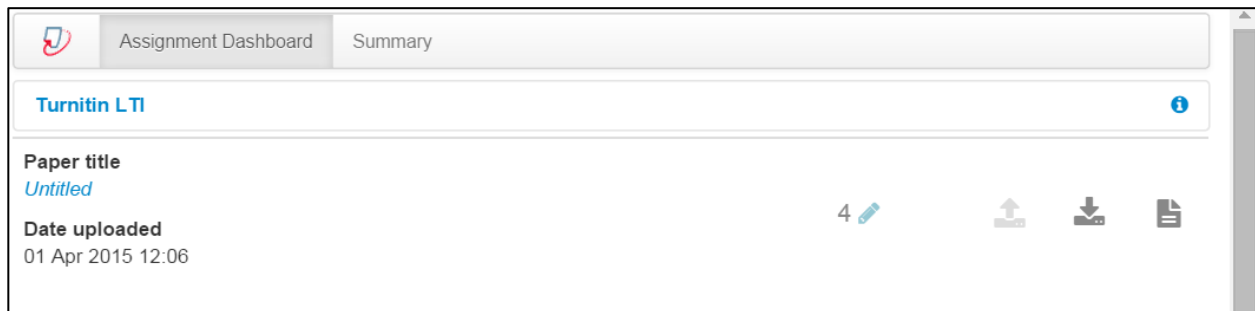
To view more details on the originality report, click on the colored icon. A screen similar to the below one, appears for your reference.



GradeMark

In case you do not find a color icon, your instructor may not have enabled that feature. In such cases, you will have to wait until your instructor grades your submission.

Once graded, you can click on the grade /points you received for that submission to view the originality report.



The report will display comments, if any, from the instructor and will be highlighted on the GradeMark tab.
