I. WestEd Report Update

- Calc-Study Interim Report Summary shared with Leads.
- Study surveyed over 3 semesters of students in Calculus undertaking flipped and traditional style of teaching. Finding the effectiveness of flipping in the classroom.
- One update from the Spring 2019 data set was the absence of the “implementation dip” which was present in the post-test scores in previous reports.
- Data shows that less prepared students reap the benefits from flipping more than their more prepared peers.
- In-class observations conclude student active engagement higher in flipped classrooms, however there is more room for students to lead the discussion on course materials during the course meeting time.
