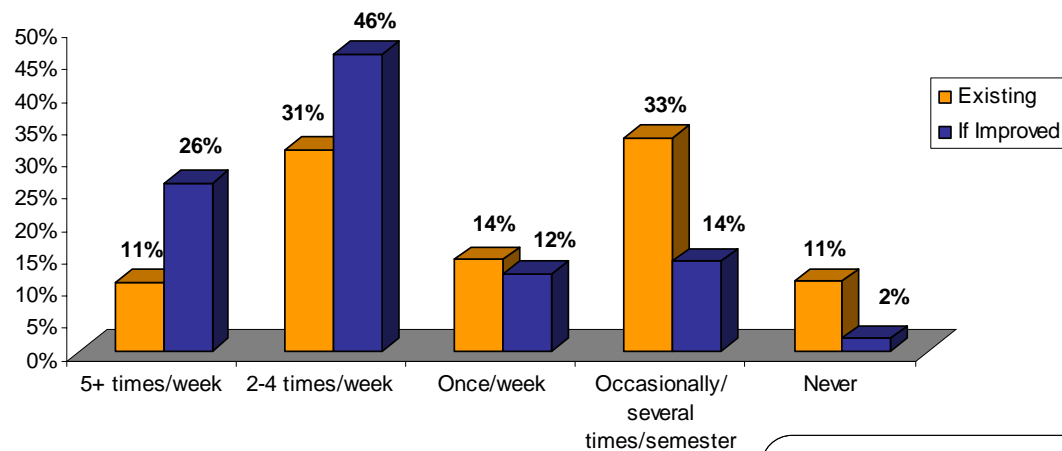

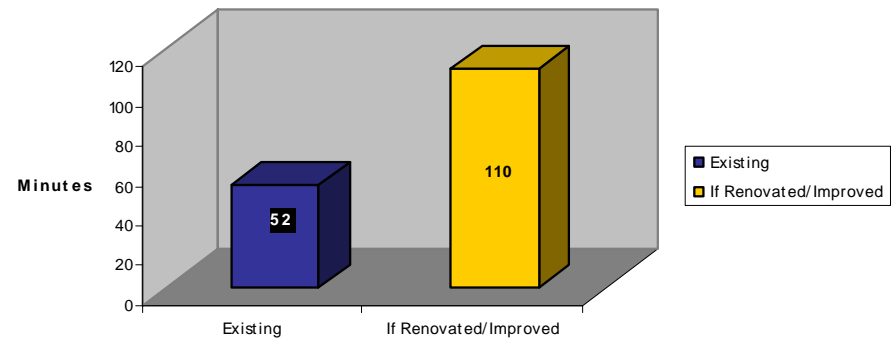


Survey Results: Union Usage

Student Union Frequency of Use

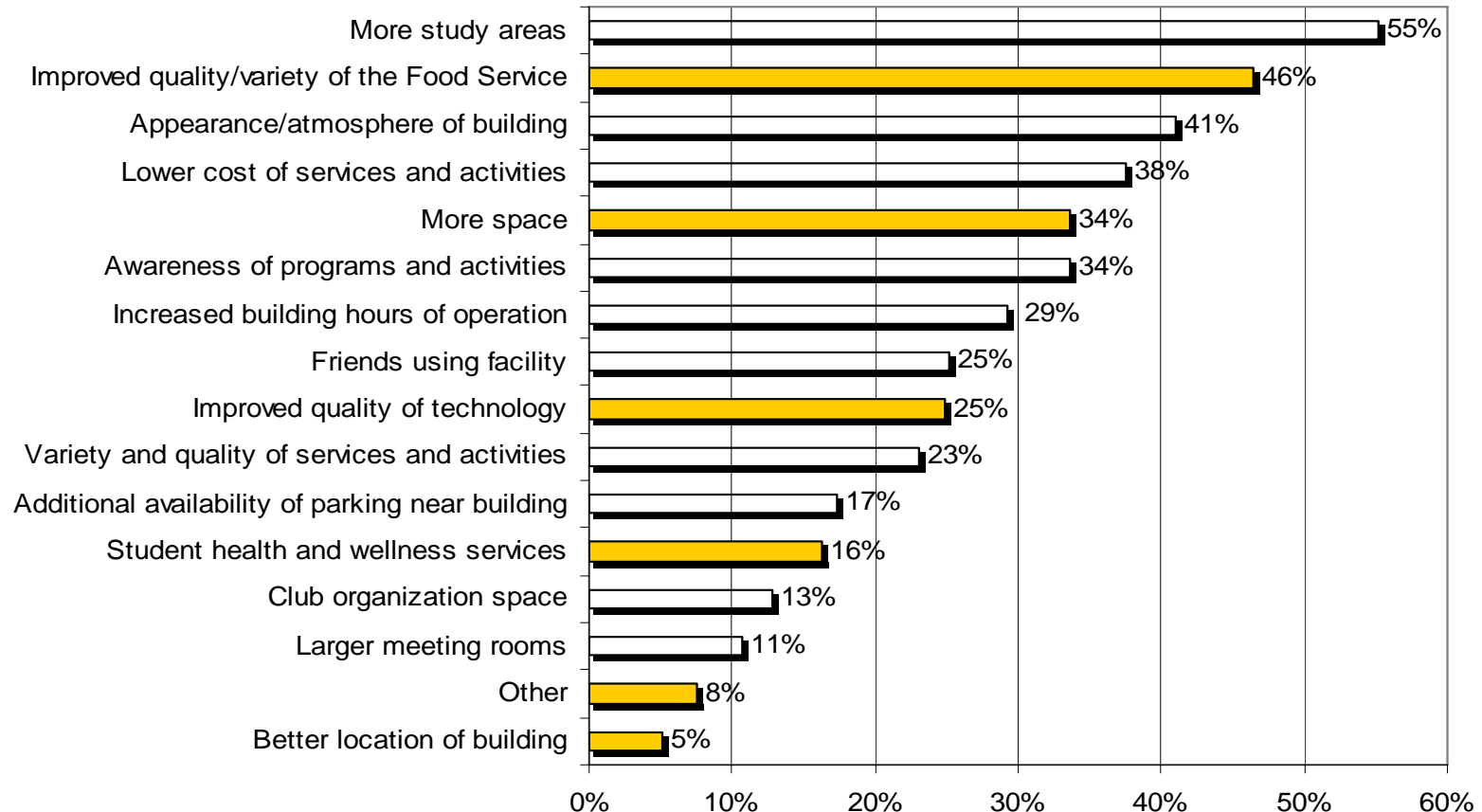


Student Union - Existing vs. Proposed Usage



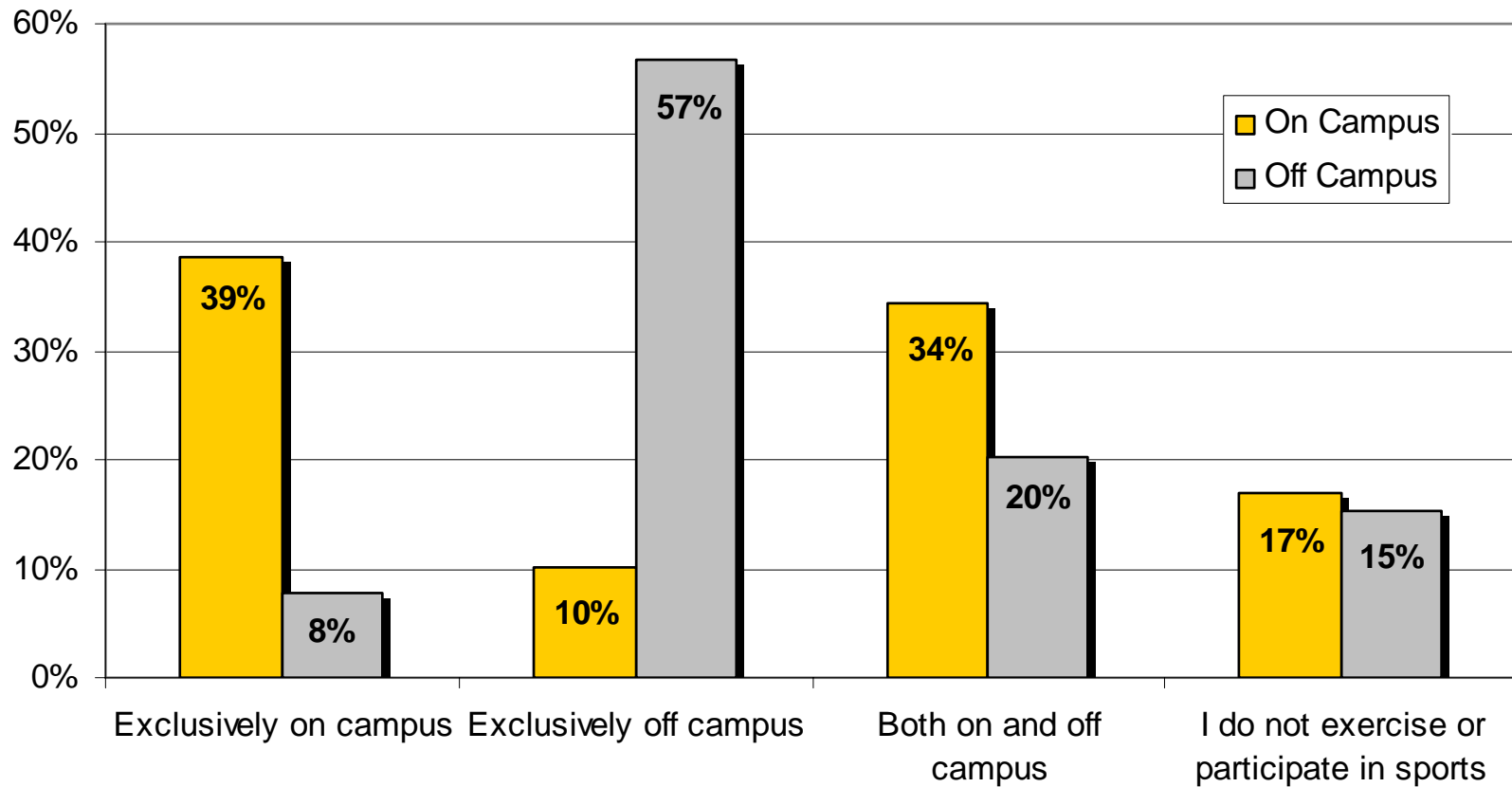

Improvements that Might Increase Student Union Usage



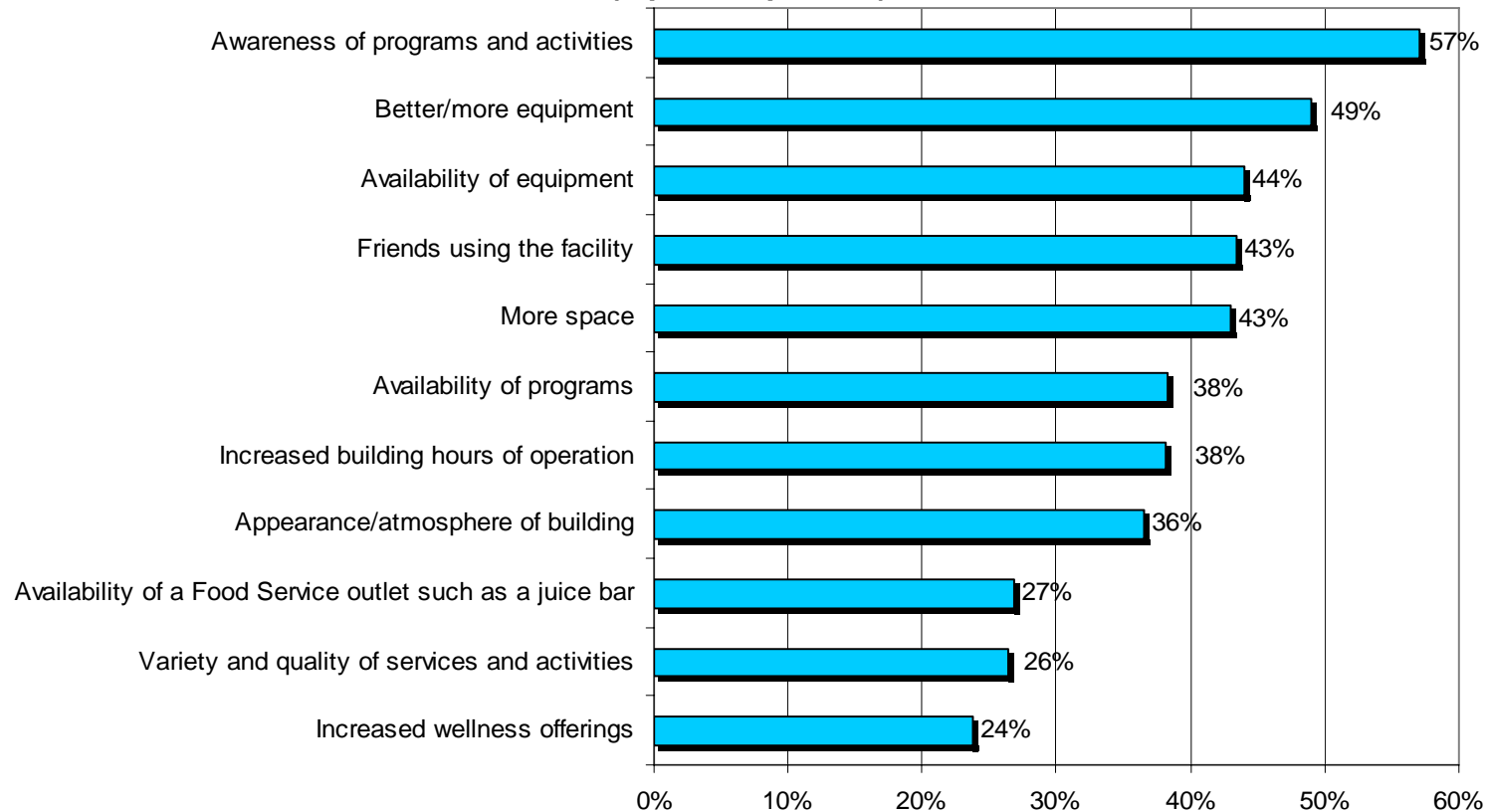
Sport Club Usage

Where do you currently participate in recreational sports & fitness activities?



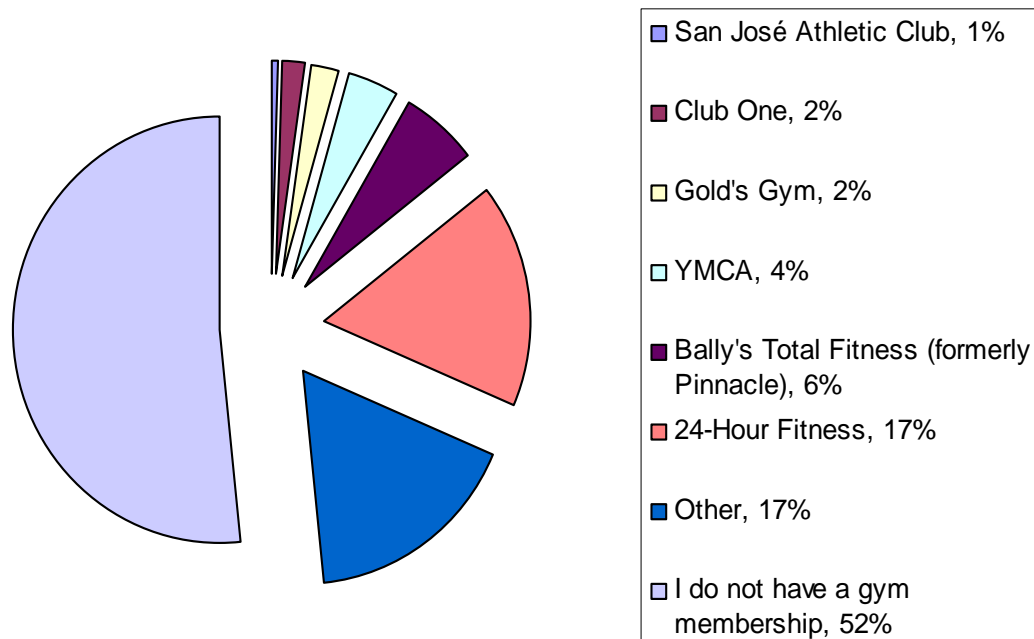

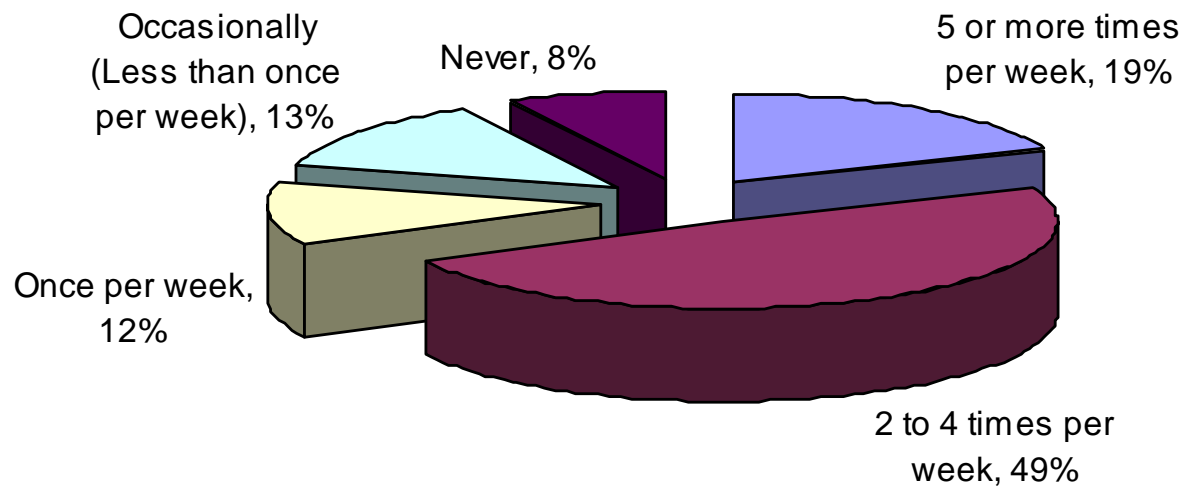

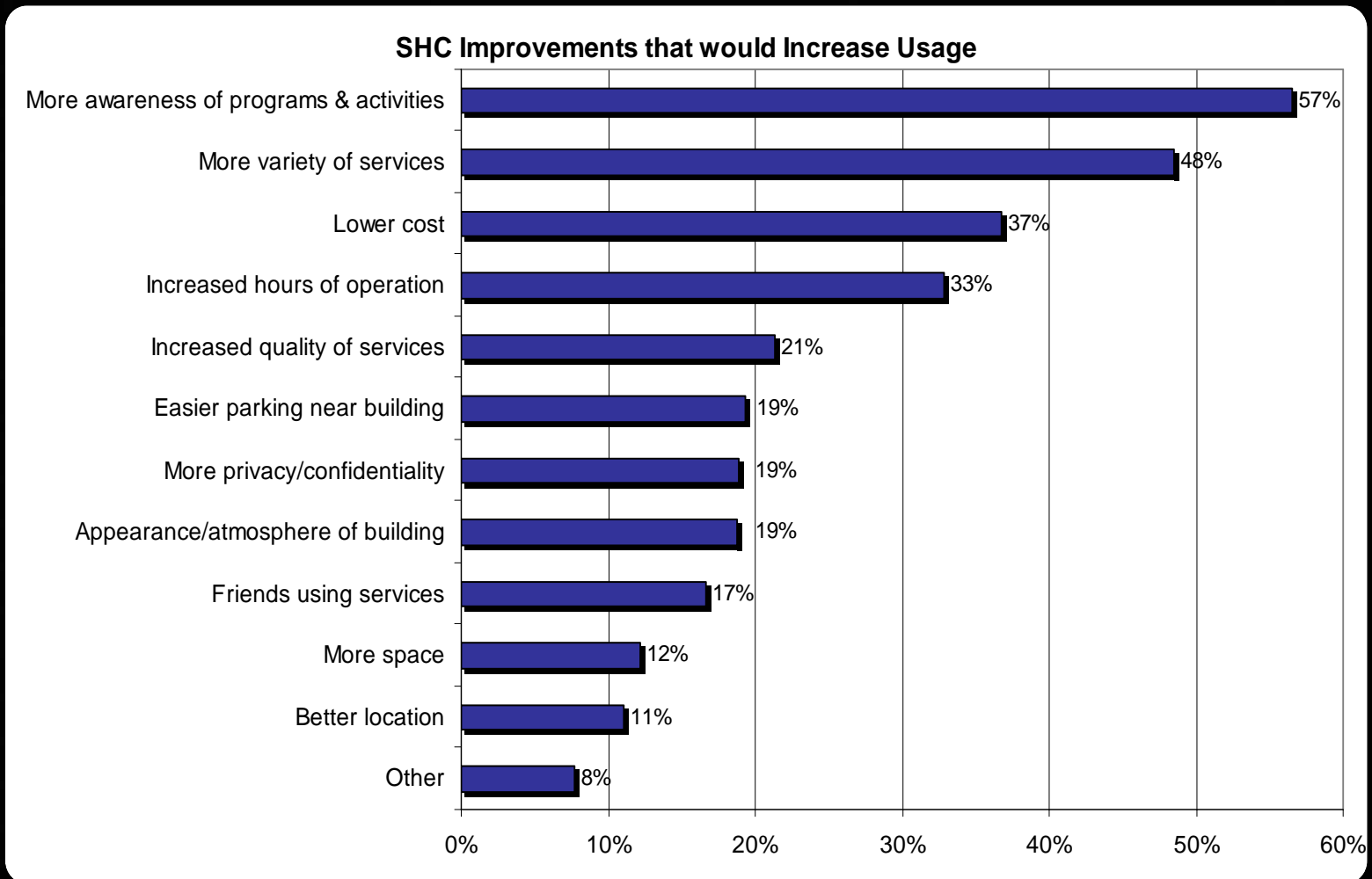


Sport Club: Increased Usage

If the Sport Club facility was expanded to meet your needs how often would you use it?

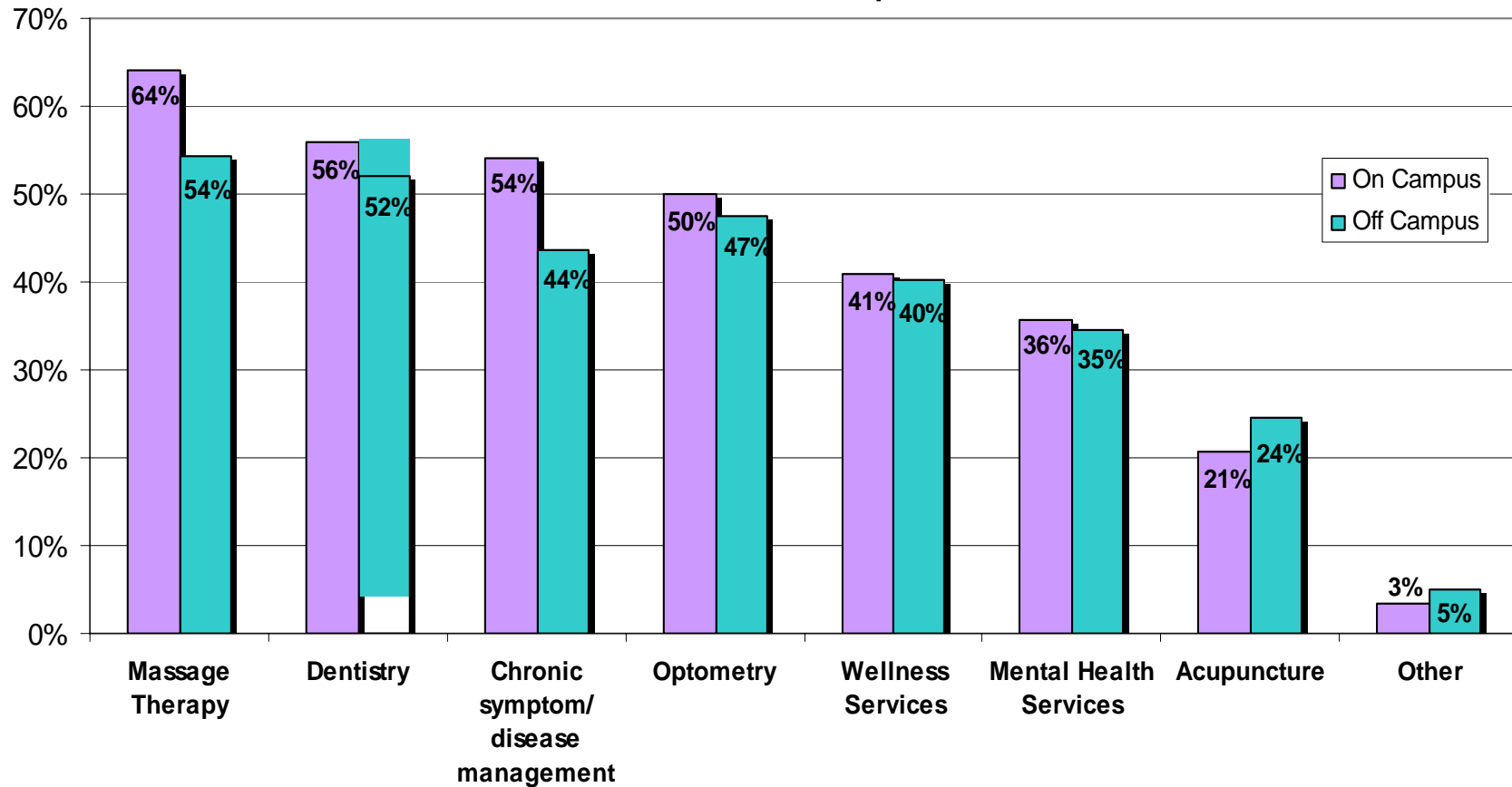

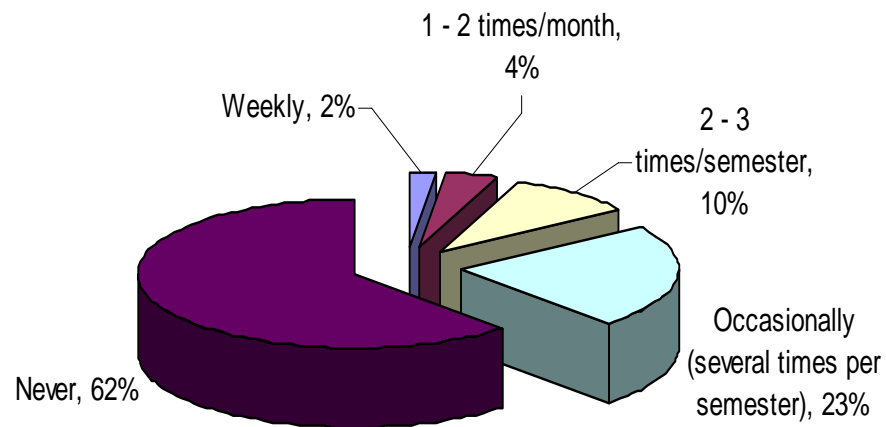

Other Desired Services in Expanded SHC

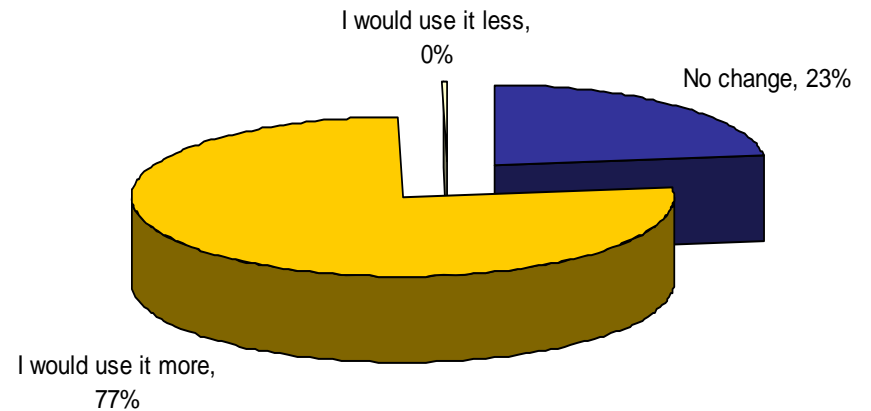

Student Health Center Usage

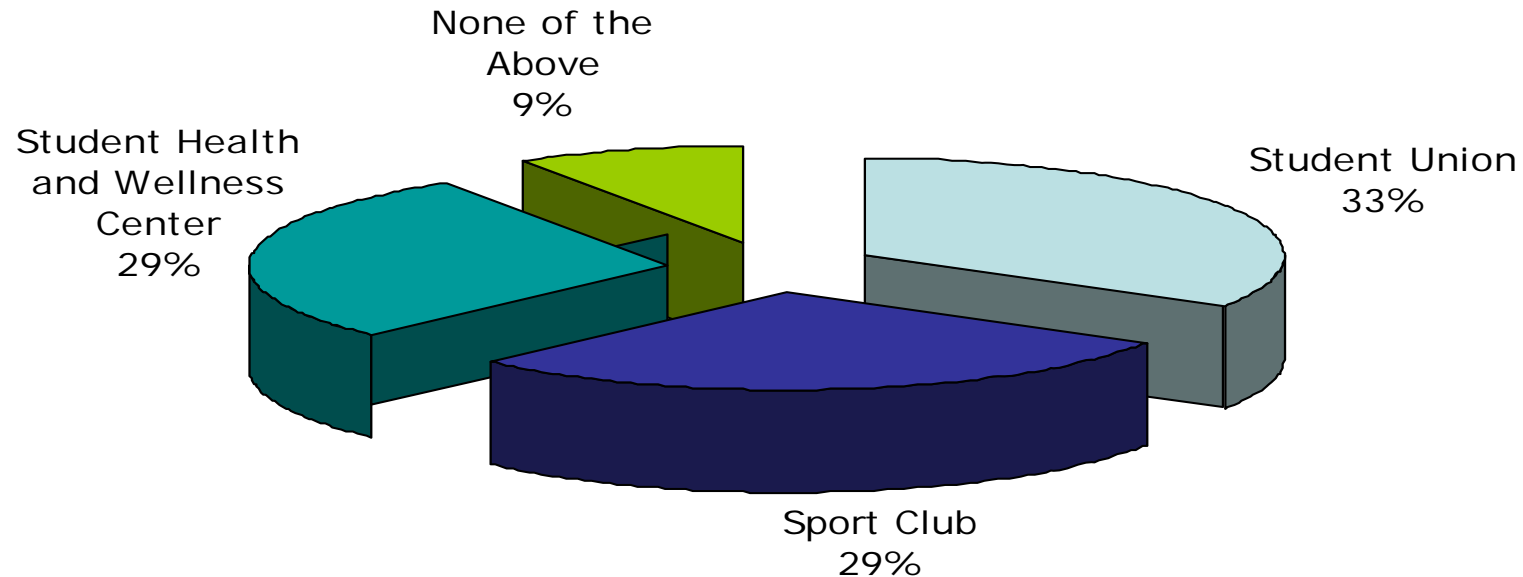


Change in SHC Usage with Improved Facility

\$1,648 per semester

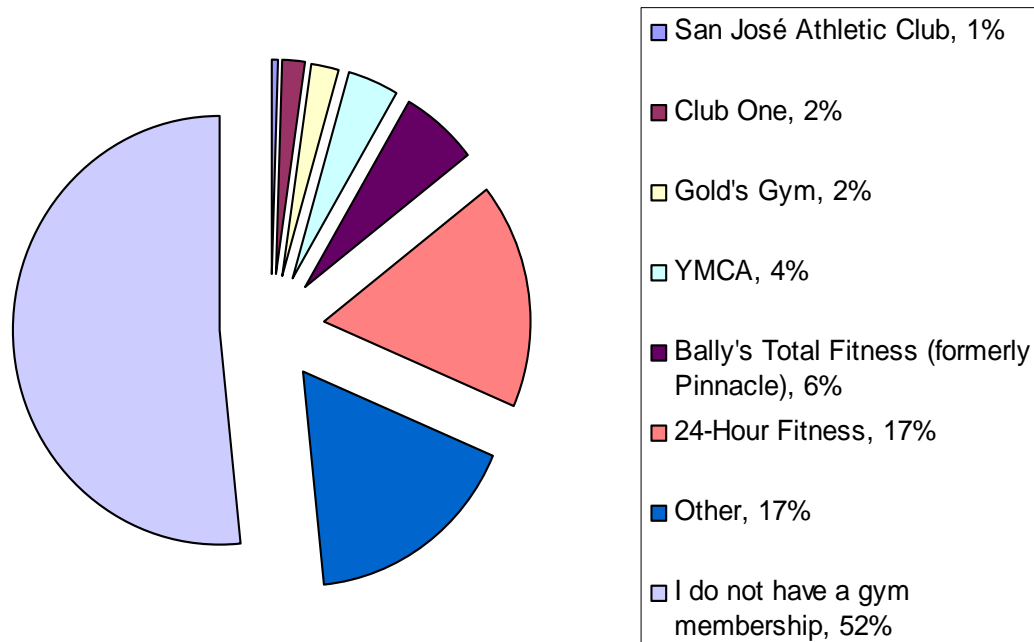
For these projects:
