Hanni Arnon is Founder & Executive Director of the Arava International Center for Agriculture Training (AICAT), which is located in Sapir, Israel, in the Negev Desert. Hanni moved to the Arava with her husband in 1981. She founded AICAT in 1994 to bring young farmers from developing countries to the Central Arava, so they could take home knowledge of its arid agricultural techniques and innovative farming practices. AICAT's founding aim was to become a leading authority in professional agricultural studies and to form global collaborations. It has graduated over 10,000 students, and aims to expand its program.



Zohar Levkovitz is the founder and former CEO of Amobee, the leading mobile corporation for far reaching mobile advertising. Within just a few years Amobee reached hundreds of millions of people and began a revolution in the way advertising can truly utilize the mobile medium. Amobee was sold for over \$300M. Zohar was recognized as Entrepreneur of the Year[™] 2011 in California, CEO of the Year 2010 in Israel, and Technology Pioneer for the World Economic Forum, all of which attest to his mark on the face of world advertising and the power to affect change. Prior to Amobee, Zohar was at the forefront of mobile and internet technology development for over a decade. As former CTO of Comverse 3G, MMS and WAP Push activities, Zohar led the development and compilation of several architectures and concepts, currently accepted as standards by the global telecom industry. Initially from a small Kibbutz in the north of Israel, Zohar journeyed from copywriter and planner for advertising agencies to technological pioneer in the span of under two decades. He is US Chairman of SpaceIL, an Israeli non-profit competing in the Google Lunar X prize to land a spacecraft on the moon in 2017.

Art is founder and CEO of YourMechanic, a startup that provides car maintenance at the convenience of the car owner's home or office at 20-30% lower cost than going to a dealer. YourMechanic, Art's second startup, took home the winning title and \$50,000, at TechCrunch Disrupt San Francisco in 2012. Over the past year, Art has raised significant capital from some of the leading investors in Silicon Valley including: Softbank, Andreessen Horowitz, Jeff Clavier, Yuri Milner, SV Angel, and Ashton Kutcher (to name a few). Prior to starting YourMechanic, Art founded a company called Care Workforce, an online marketplace to help hospitals hire temp nurses on demand and lower costs by 10-30%. He studied Liberal Arts at Drexel University in Pennsylvania.
